
Spring Term 1: Mon 4 Jan - Fri 12 Feb



Welcome back to another busy and exciting term in Year 2. First of all, Mrs Choudhry, Mrs Healey and I would like to say a big thank you to all the parents and children who kindly gave us cards and gifts for Christmas. We hope you all had a lovely Christmas holidays.

This half term's learning we aim to cover:

English: We will be using 'Talk for Writing' home learning booklets. Booklet one is called 'The Magical Teaching Box' and is based on a myth from Ancient Greece called Pandora's Box. As well as reading



the story in this booklet, the children will have opportunities to draw, create, play with words and read and write poetry. Booklet two is called 'Rainbows, Rainbows, Everywhere'. This booklet is based on non-fiction texts and the children will use their English skills to find out about rainbows.



Maths: The children will begin by learning about money. The daily White Rose videos will support the children with this. This is a topic that all children find difficult and therefore using real money at home will support the children with their understanding. Playing games such as shops, can support your child in handling coins and notes and support them with giving change. Maths home learning will then move onto multiplication and division.



Learning Challenge: In our learning challenge topic we will be starting the question 'Who is Queen Elizabeth's Great-Great Grandma?'. Our topic will include learning about the royal family and learning about Queen Victoria and her life as a monarch. Resources and web links are included within the home learning booklet and website to support the children.

Science: Our new science topic is Animals including Humans. Throughout this unit, the children will be investigating health, growth and survival for both animals and humans.



RE: In RE this term, we will be starting our new topic 'Who made the world?'. In the home learning provided, the children will learn about the creation story and the days of creation.
