Whole class brass lessons will continue to take place next year for **Years 4 & 5** and instruments will be provided for this.

All other instruments are taught by teachers from the Bradford Council Music Service – and can be booked online at <https://ukbradfordmusic.speedadmin.dk/registration#/>.

All the lessons are taught during school hours and the cost varies, depending upon whether you wish your child to receive tuition as part of a small group (£70 per term) or individually (£188 per term through the Music Service/£140 per term for Piano/Keyboard/Guitar/Ukulele). Children will receive a minimum of 30 lessons per academic year. Please note that there can be no guarantee of a space being available on any instrument, and therefore it is advised that you apply for lessons as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

If your child receives **Pupil Premium** funding, please do not contact the providers directly as this is organised through school. If you have not yet made your preferences, please contact me as soon as possible.

Please note this letter is for new starters only; lessons already taking place will continue automatically, unless you inform Mr Sweet, Mrs Sweet or Bradford Council directly.
