



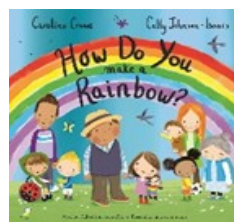
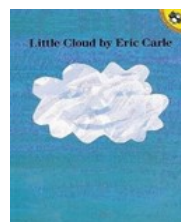
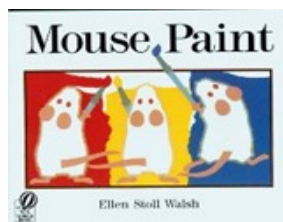
Nursery Class Newsletter

Dear Parents/Carers,

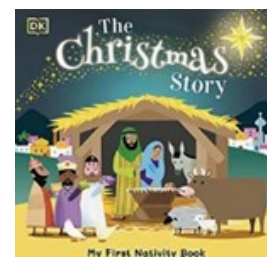
This term, our topic is '**What makes our world colourful?**'. We are reading some lovely books including, 'How do you make a rainbow?', 'Tree', 'Little cloud', 'Mouse paint', and 'The colour of us'. We will be talking about all the different things in the world that make our lives colourful; the colours of the weather and seasons, the different people in the world, the colours of our favourite things and all the colours in the rainbow.



We have now started the '**Little Wandle**' **phonics scheme** with the book 'Monster clothes' and the rhyme 'Mary, Mary, Quite contrary' and this is going really well.
