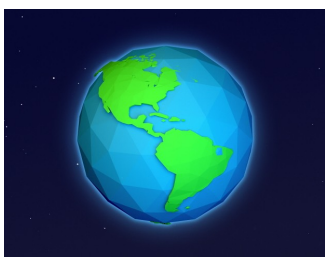
English: The focus for this term will be the book, 'Katie in London' by James Mayhew. This is an engaging text that takes us on a journey across London where we will visit some famous landmarks. We will use this book to support us in writing a report about London at the end of the unit. If any of the children have visited London, either in the past or recently, and would like to share any pictures of their visit, please do send them in.

Maths: In Maths we will continue with addition and subtraction before moving onto shape. Key number facts, such as number bonds and times tables, continue to be a focus and these are practiced regularly throughout the week.

History: In History we will embark on the question 'Who wears the crown?'. Our topic will include learning about King Charles III, Queen Elizabeth II and Queen Victoria. We will be watching parts of the King's coronation and comparing it to Queen Elizabeth's coronation in 1953.



Science: Our new science question is 'What do we need to keep healthy?' Throughout this unit, the children will be investigating health, growth and survival for animals, including humans.



RE: In RE this term, we will be starting our new topic 'Who made the world?'. Children will 'dig deeper' into the creation story and the days leading up to creation. During this exploration, art will be used to allow the children to express the excitement of creation and a PSHE link of recycling and looking after our world will be included.

DT: We are really looking forward to Enterprise Week this half term! This will be held during the final week and will culminate with our Enterprise market. We can't wait to share our creations with you so watch this space!

Just a reminder that PE days are Wednesday and Friday. Our PE focus this half term will be basketball and football. Please ensure that PE items are named as we cannot return items that are not identifiable. A reminder that reading books can be changed by the children at any point in school and we ask that they bring their reading book to school each day.
