Firstly, a very warm welcome to all our new Parents and Carers. We have had a fantastic start to the school year and it has been amazing to see how well all the children have settled in.

Our topic for this term is 'What makes me Marvelous?'. We will be learning about all the things that make us special, our feelings, and our families and friendships. We would love the children to tell us all about themselves and their families; to help them do this it would be lovely if you could send in some family pictures, including a baby photo of your child, grandparents, and extended family. (Photos can either be supplied as a paper copy or you can upload it on to Tapestry.) We will be talking about differences between us and between young and old. We will be sharing some lovely texts, including, 'Who are you?', 'Incredible you', 'Kindness makes us strong', 'The Family book', 'Elmer' and 'Feelings'.



Tapestry

We are using Tapestry to record 'wow' moments and milestones for your child. You should have received log in details so that you can see what your child has been doing. Please let us know if you have any problems or haven't received the email.

'Muddy Monday'



On **Mondays** we will be having 'Muddy Monday' where we will go out for a walk in the school grounds, to use our senses and explore our surroundings. Please can you ensure that your child has wellies and a suitable coat with them. (These can be left in Nursery).

On **Wednesdays and alternate Mondays (starting 14th Sept)** we will be doing our PE session. Please can all children come to Nursery in comfortable trousers/leggings and trainers/pumps.

Reminders
